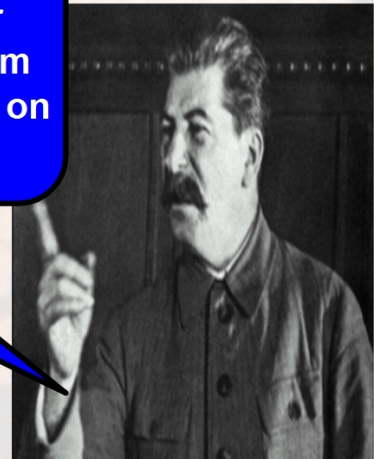

## How Did the Cold War Develop? Lesson 2: - "Spy versus Spy"



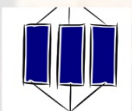
Learning gain - we are going to explore in more depth the two competing cold war ideologies of capitalism and communism and examine how these ideas impacted on the people who lived under them.



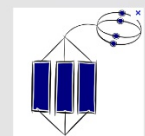
### Learning Steps:
