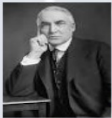

**Was the New Deal a Success?**

- The New Deal achieved much and helped the suffering of millions of Americans.
  - Solved the Banking Crisis.
  - Helped improve the income of farmers.
  - Provided work for millions of Americans.
  - Supported Young Americans
  - Modernised infrastructure and provided electricity to the Tennessee Valley.
  - In 4 years between 1933 and 1938 unemployment fell by 4 million.

★ Possible Failings: ★

★ Black people did less well - in 1935 a third of all Black Americans relied on relief payments.

★ Farm labourers remained in poverty existing on low wages. Those in the Dustbowl were even worse off.

Once the government stopped Pump Priming in 1937 unemployment rose. Roosevelt had to put more money in.



## World War 2

From 1939 the USA benefitted from the war from supplying materials and supplies to Britain and France. Demand for manufactured goods and food rose.

This led to a boost to the cycle of recovery and unemployment began to fall.

When the USA entered the war against Japan and Germany its economy was put on a war time footing and it was lifted out of Depression.

The New Deal brought great changes to the USA.

The Federal Government became much more involved in the lives of citizens than ever before.

It was the WAR that ended the Depression.
